# Be Among the First!

Village at Belmar is pleased to be able to offer the COVID-19 vaccine to residents and team members through our partner pharmacy, CVS, once it is available.

The first tier to receive the vaccine will be our assisted living and memory care residents.

This follows the recommendations of the CDC's Advisory Community on Immunization Practices (ACIP), which designated that healthcare personnel and residents of long-term communities will be among the first in line for the vaccine. Distribution could begin soon after Christmas based on current information.

The vaccine will be free of charge to residents and team members of Village At Belmar. It will be stored, distributed and administered by CVS Pharmacy.

#### Here is how it will work:

CVS will work with our staff to arrange dates and times for resident vaccinations.

The CVS team, working closely with our clinical team, will administer the vaccine at Village at Belmar.

Each resident and team member will need two doses of the vaccine, given approximately 3 weeks apart. CVS will follow all testing requirements established by the CDC and will report vaccination data to the local, state and federal jurisdictions within 72 hours of administering a dose.
